

BRAMMO powercycle Direct Sales Instructions

Follow these simple steps to complete your order and receive delivery of your new BRAMMO Enertia powercycle. Then enjoy the pleasure of 100% electric transportation!

Direct Sales Contract

With these instructions you will have received a copy of the BRAMMO Enertia sales contract. This contract needs to be signed by you and then returned to BRAMMO. Please do not make any modifications or changes to the contract as this will prevent us from accepting your order. Once you have signed the contract you can either mail it to our head quarters, fax it, or e-mail it as a digitally signed or scanned PDF.

Payment

Once we receive your signed contract and your payment has cleared, we will issue an invoice to you indicating that you have paid in full and we will then contact you to arrange shipping.

Checks, Money Order, and Cashier's Checks

You may include your contract with your payment. We recommend sending your payment through certified mail as BRAMMO is not responsible for any payment or contracts lost in the mail.

Credit Card

If you paid by credit card online, we will automatically finish processing your payment once we receive the signed contract.

Delivery

Your Brammo Enertia powercycle will be delivered by a trained shipping agent who will unload the Enertia and hand over the associated documents. The Enertia will be uncrated and you will have an opportunity to inspect the bike before signing a delivery acceptance certificate. This in no way affects your 12 month warranty or any other statutory rights.

DMV Registration

You will then need to contact your local DMV and register your BRAMMO Enertia. To do this you will need insurance coverage and the Manufacturers Certificate of Origin (MCO). This certificate allows DMV to issue your title document for the Enertia. Your DMV office may want to inspect the Enertia. The Enertia has a sticker with the VIN on one side of the chassis and the EPA sticker on the other side. In addition, the electric motor has a serial number that is clearly visible and some DMV offices will want to record this number as the engine number.

When you register your Enertia with DMV you may be asked to pay a fee equivalent to the sales tax in your state this is sometimes called a usage tax. There is no sales tax in Oregon and BRAMMO have not collected any sales tax on the sale of your Enertia. In some states it is possible to claim back the sales tax on electric vehicles. Please check with your local IRS office to determine if you are eligible.

Warranty Registration

Please sign and return the warranty registration document that arrives with your Enertia and mail it to Brammo at the address above. Once we receive the warranty card we will acknowledge receipt and invite you to complete a customer satisfaction survey.
